Why Should You Have A 3D High Resolution Mammogram?

A mammogram is an x-ray examination of the breasts, used to detect and diagnose breast disease.

1 in every 8 women will develop breast cancer within her lifetime and 8 out of 9 women diagnosed with breast cancer have no family history.

It is recommended by The American College of Radiology that patients at average risk for breast cancer begin annual screening mammography at age 40.

Our Women's Imaging Center at The Toledo Clinic focuses on privacy and comfort while keeping costs significantly lower than the area health systems.

A low dose of radiation is used during the examination so your radiation exposure is kept below the FDA guidelines. The Genius™ 3D Mammography™ exam reduces callbacks by up to 40% and is proven to find 20-65% more invasive breast cancers.

How is Mammography Performed?

You will need to undress above the waist for this procedure. You will be given a warm gown to wear during the mammogram. You and a board certified mammographer will be the only ones present during the mammogram. The mammographer will position each breast, one at a time, on the mammography equipment. The breast will then be compressed and the tomographic, high resolutioin, 3D x-ray will be taken.

The image will appear on the mammographer's computer screen and they will be able to make sure each image is of highest diagnostic quality before positioning you for the next tomographic, high resolution, 3D x-ray.

The entire process should take about 20 minutes.



Please come prepared for your mammogram by removing any perfume, powders or deodorant normally worn.

After Your Mammogram:

Following your mammogram, you can dress and return to your normal routine.

Your mammogram will be read by a board certified radiologist. The radiologist will send a report to your physician within 48 hours. You will receive a letter from The Toledo Clinic regarding your results within 7 days.

Be sure to check with your physician when you receive the results of your mammogram. If you do not hear from your physician, DO NOT assume your mammogram was normal. Confirm this by calling your physician's office.

The Toledo Clinic will also send a yearly reminder for your annual screening mammogram.
